

## The Robert and Maude Gledden Short Stay Visiting Fellowships

The Robert and Maude Gledden Short Stay Fellowships are part of the estate bequeathed to the University by the late Robert John Gledden to promote and encourage education and research at the University in the disciplines of applied science, more particularly relating to surveying, engineering, mining or cognate subjects. The purpose of the fellowship is to provide travel costs and living expenses for accommodation for scholars outside of Western Australia.

The Robert and Maude Gledden Short Stay Fellowships are open to researchers who have doctoral degrees, or equivalent qualifications or experience. Early, mid-career and senior researchers are eligible to apply.

### Remuneration

The Short Stay Visiting Fellowships provide a maximum of AUD\$3000 to assist with travel and accommodation expenses. Honoraria, stipends, living allowances or salaries are not provided as part of the grant. Funding is not provided for accompanying family.

### Applications

Applications for Short Stay Visiting Fellowships may be lodged at any time during the year, and will be awarded subject to funding availability. Applications are assessed by the Institute of Advanced Studies. Applications that do not relate to the fields of surveying, engineering, mining or cognate subjects will not be considered. Applications must be lodged by a UWA-based researcher.

Notification of Short Stay Visiting Fellowship awards are usually made within 30 days of application during the academic year.

### Terms and Conditions

Gledden Short Stay Visiting Fellows

- Agree to cite UWA and acknowledge the Fellowship in publications resulting from this award;
- Acknowledge that any IP resulting in commercialisation from this collaboration will be negotiated at an appropriate time following UWA Guidelines;
- Agree to provide a final report and participate in periodic surveys by the Institute of Advanced Studies requesting follow-up information on research outcomes that have resulted from the Fellowship;
- Provide a public lecture and/or masterclass for the Institute of Advanced Studies.
