Dr Peter Phillips is a Professor of Political Studies (2004-present), Director of the College of Biotechnology (2002-5) and an associate member in the Departments of Management and Marketing and Agricultural Economics at the University of Saskatchewan. He previously was a Professor in Agricultural Economics and NSERC/SSHRC Chair in Managing Knowledge-Based Agri-Food Development (1999-2004), Van Vliet Chair Professor (1997-99), Assistant Deputy Minister, Saskatchewan Economic Development (1992-97); Director, Policy and Research, Saskatchewan Economic Diversification and Trade (1990-92); Senior Economist, Executive Council (1983-87); and, Research Economist, Royal Bank of Canada, Montreal (1981-83). He received a Ph.D. in International Political Economy (1989) and a M.Sc. in Economics (1981) from the London School of Economics and Political Science. Dr Phillips has authored and co-authored many publications.

The **IAS Masterclass** program combines a visit to UWA by a distinguished scholar with a session involving a group of presentations by postgraduate students.

Over a one-day period, students present short papers on their own research or interests within the framework of the stated topic, and each presentation is then discussed by the group. On a subsequent day, the students have the opportunity of an individual consultation with the visiting Fellow.

The IAS provides the venue for the presentations and informal discussions. We hope that the ambience of the IAS makes the occasion special for the participants, separate from their usual environments and free of departmental associations, a particularly useful feature for cross-disciplinary groups.

**All interested students and staff from Perth universities are invited to attend.**

This is a cross-disciplinary masterclass and submissions are welcome across all relevant disciplines.

We are aiming for no more than eight papers to be given during the day. Limited places will be available for those who wish to attend but do not wish to give a paper.
